**The Benefice of St Michael's and St Mary's**  
**Lent Course 2019 - Inspiring Music in Worship**

You are invited to join in with our Lent Course which is a course for everyone, to help us to listen to each other and listen to God afresh regarding the worship at St Michael's and St Mary's. No specialist music skill is needed. We all have valuable experiences of worship, so everyone can contribute. The course is divided into 5 sessions which will take place at St Michael's on Wednesday evenings 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> March and 3<sup>rd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> April from 7-9pm.

The sessions are:

1. What does it mean to be a worshipping person?
2. Discovering skills and releasing gifts.
3. Music and mission.
4. Starting from where we are.
5. Setting a new vision for music and worship.
