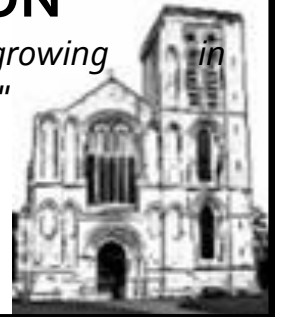

- 4 He shall call the heaven / from a/bove : and the earth that / he may / judge his / people.
- 5 Gather my saints together / unto / me : those that have made a / covenant with / me with / sacrifice.
- 6 And the heavens shall de/clare his / righteousness : for / God is / Judge him/ self.
- 7 Hear O my people and / I will / speak : I myself will testify against thee O Israel, for I am God / even / thy / God.
- 8 I will not reprove thee because of thy sacrifices, or for thy / burnt-/ offerings : because they / were not / alway be/fore me.
- 9 I will take no bullock / out of thine / house : nor / he-goat / out of thy / folds.
- 10 For all the beasts of the / forest are / mine : and so are the cattle up/on a / thousand / hills.
- 11 I know all the fowls up/on the / mountains : and the wild beasts of the / field are / in my / sight.
- 12 If I be hungry I / will not / tell thee : for the whole world is mine and / all that / is there/in.
- 13 Thinkest thou that I will / eat bulls' / flesh : and / drink the / blood of / goats?
- 14 Offer unto / God / thanksgiving : and pay thy vows / unto the / most / Highest.
- 15 And call upon me in the / time of / trouble : so will I / hear thee and / thou shalt / praise me.
